Orphan To Philanthropist

Priya Jemima an orphan in Chennai, she has no memory of her parents. Sadly her parents had committed suicide of financial crisis and left her alone. She was abandoned as a 3 year old child by her relatives, except her grandmother. Her grandmother left her in an orphanage which was run by IID – Inter Mission Industrial Development. In this orphanage, her expenses were sponsored by unseen – kind hearted family from Germany. She has never seen them till today.

She was a bright student from her young age and has completed her 12th grade in a nearby government school. After 12th grade, she acquired a job in a DTP centre as steno. And she moved to a working women hostel. And she started pursuing her higher studies. Then she was working as salesperson in Apple phone store. And worked as marketing executive in Marry brown (food chain restaurant) and Marketing manager in Meat and Eat (food chain restaurant). At present she is running a manufacturing and sales company.

From her childhood, Priya Jemima had a motive to help others and she started her philanthropist journey by supporting underprivileged student's financially to pursue education. Years passed by and in 2017, she started an NGO (GEO INDIA FOUNDATION) and begins full-fledged philanthropist work.

Wonder Women Care

Access to menstrual hygiene products is an essential, often overlooked, component of women's rights. Under this campaign our volunteers are regularly visiting the rural area/ slum area/ Govt. School and villages for creating awareness among pubescent girls and women about the importance of using sanitary napkins.



Feed The Hunger

Solving hunger lays the foundation for progress in many other areas of development, including health and education. We cook/procure food and distribute healthy food packets to the homeless and needy at the time crisis, natural disaster and was scaled up at times of covid lockdown.

Purpose

Constructed - Women Empowerment centre in nelveli village in uthiramerur taluk. The impression of our empowerment centre will be the improvement of more skillful and semi-skillful personnel who will contribute to economic growth and social development. Our Project purpose is to reduce poverty and promote economic growth by providing skills training to tribal and the disadvantaged community. Our Program's anticipated outcome is increasing access by various potential trainees to and held together the capacity of technical and vocational education.

Our approach

- > Ensure providing of training, employment specific and income generation activities
- > Ensures the ultimate goal of making all women financially independent and self-sufficient.
- > To provide awareness on social issues to adolescent girls and women.
- > To endorse and to associated with the trained institutes.
- > To strengthen training and placements opportunities for the trained girls and women.
- > To promote training to the young girls and women from the community management for women and young girls in the rural areas.

GIF Empowerment | Impact Snapshot

- > Through our tailoring institute, every year more than 300 women in the rural village were empowered with tailoring knowledge
- > Women were given proper skill training in stitching and embroidery.
- > Also we procured job work from various garments companies for these women for their livelihood.

Menstrual pad Manufacturing

- > Providing employment in our napkin making unit,
- > Providing training and employ them for production
- > Produced menstrual pads are then distributed in our supply chain for our vending machines donated to the respective institution at free of cost.
- > Donating free sanitary pads to the pubescent government school girls and public.
- > Some of the finished products are sold to the corporates

A World in Crisis

As the unique challenges of 2020 continuously unfolded, we knew we had to play a role in responding to greatest needs and providing aid to the people affected. Tackling multiple, multi-faceted crises was a tall order for our team. We took learning's from our years of experience driving solutions in underserved communities and applied them forward to prioritize. During covid crisis, we had distributed 240000 well packed healthy meal to the frontline staffs in Hospitals and sanitation workers in Chennai and Delhi.

COVID Relief

As an organization that routinely responds to disaster, we are well equipped to mobilize resources and act quickly. When COVID-19 arrived, we used that framework to address the growing emergency with a targeted, accelerated plan to help.

Pandemic Other Response

Supported communities impacted by COVID, including the following services:

- **COVID Response** Distributed emergency food boxes to 11500 frontline staff, public and scheduled tribes
- **Direct Relief**
Obtained and delivered personal protective equipment to help meet the needs of frontline health workers at over 5 community health centers in the Chennai
- **Tribal Boys & Girls**
Supported 500+ tribal childrens with school supplies and books
- **Medicines Is Fundamental**
Supported at- 11 old age home with medical supplies.
- **Ration supply to tribal village**
Supported 1500+ ration kit to families of tribal villages and old age homes
- **PPE kit**
Provided hundreds of PPE kit for healthcare workers
- **Non-profit support**
Distributed 15000 litres of disinfectant solution to 18 nonprofits to address urgent challenges faced by communities
